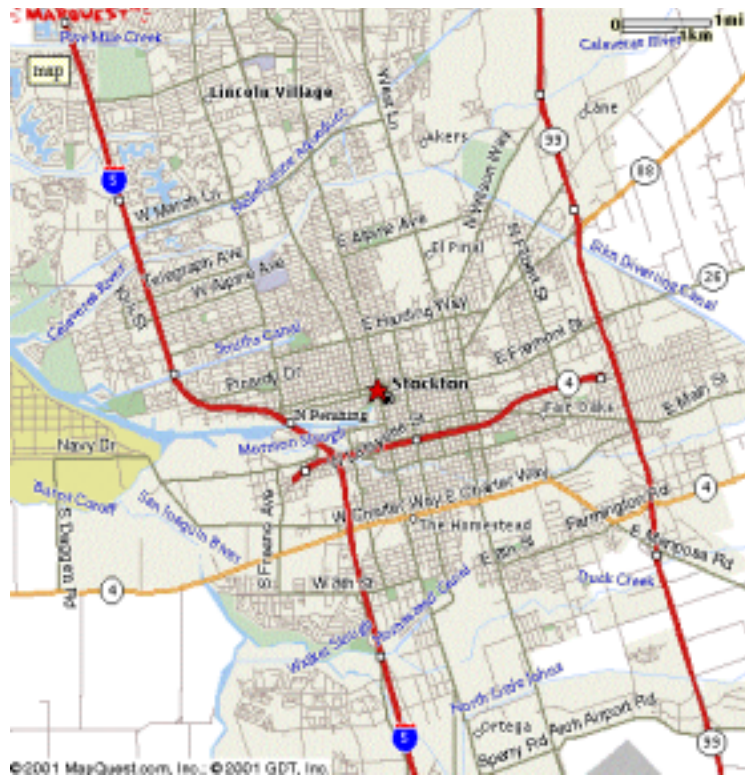


General Directions to the Cesar Chavez Central Library 605 N. El Dorado St. Stockton, CA 95202

If you are coming to Stockton from outside the area, you may use either Highway 99 or Highway I-5. As you near Stockton from either North or South, there will be an offramp choice named Highway 4 or Crosstown Freeway. This highway connects 99 and I-5 and leads to the Downtown Stockton exit (also called the El Dorado St exit).

If you are coming from 99, at the foot of the El Dorado St. offramp, turn right (North) and go 8 blocks. The Library is surrounded by 1-way streets, so you must go around the block. Turn Left on Park St. Turn Left on Center St. Finally, turn left on Oak St. This puts you in front of the Library.

If you are coming from I-5, at the foot of the offramp, you will be at Center St., which is 1-way South. Go forward one block East. Turn Left (North) at El Dorado St. Go North 8 blocks. The Library is surrounded by 1-way streets, so you must go around the block. Turn Left on Park St. Turn Left on Center St. Finally, turn left on Oak St. You will be in front of the Library.

Once you are in town and have found the Library, the main parking is on Oak St. This is 1-hour parking, so you must be careful not to leave your car there beyond the limit or you may get a ticket. If you expect to stay longer than an hour, there is a City of Stockton free parking lot on Center St. one block West of the Library.
